Benefits -

- Great Way to Bring Attention To any Activity
- Provides Recognition to Contributions People Make
- Shows Commitment to Goals and Mission

What Makes a Good Picture?

- Minimization - Take Close-up photos of the Main Subject/Activity
- Make Sure the Photos are in Focus
- Provide "Action" in the Photos - Show people engaged in an Activity
- Keep File size to 76 - 100 ppi (Pixils Per Inch) to Expedite Electronic Transmission

What You Should Submit With Each Photo -

- Make Sure the Photo File has a Title or Description of the Event
- Identify Where the Photo Was Taken
- Attach a Short Summary of the Event
